Judges Profiles ***



CRAIG REVEL HORWOOD

Craig is a well-known face on television in the UK and now, all over the world as a judge on all ten series of BBC1's *Strictly Come Dancing*, presented by Bruce Forsyth and Tess Daly.

He was also a judge on *Strictly Come Dancing Special, Comic Relief Does Fame Academy, Strictly Ice Dancing, Strictly African Dancing* and appears regularly on BBC2's *It Takes Two* with Zoe Ball.

In 2012 Craig won the BBC 2 series *Maestro at the Opera*, the final of which saw him conduct Act II of *La Bohème* at the Royal Opera House. He was also a grand finalist on the hit cooking show, *Celebrity MasterChef* and participated in and won *Ready, Steady, Cook*. Craig has also recently appeared on *The Wright Stuff, Would I Lie to You?, Market Kitchen, Celebrity Juice, John Bishop's Britain, Fern, Scream if you Know the Answer, Pointless, Great Antiques Roadtrip, Lunch with Gino and Mel, 8 out of 10 Cats, The Magicians, Alan Carr Chatty Man, Be Your Own Boss, The Royal Variety Performance, Room 101 and The Sarah Millican Television Programme.*



DENISE VAN OUTEN

Denise van Outen first came to our screens after joining Channel 4 's The Big Breakfast team in 1996.

Stage success soon followed with hugely successful starring roles in Chicago, Tell Me on a Sunday, Legally Blond, Rent

Her success on Broadway gave her a taste for the US and Denise

headed to LA to front NBC's Grease: You're the One That I Want! Her pull back to the UK came in the form of a personal phone call from Lord Andrew Lloyd Webber.

Denise joined the panel for BBC1's Any Dream Will Do! And in 2008 I'd Do Anything. She was the host of Sky1's Hairspray: The School Musical. As if 2008 wasn't busy enough she also co-hosted and performed with Michael Buble for ITV's One Night Only.

Denise reached the final of BBC1's Strictly Come Dancing in December 2012. Last year Denise embarked on a West End run of her one woman show Some Girl I Used to Know, hosts her own show on Magic FM every Saturday from 1 pm-3 pm and most recently played the role of Karin Smart in Eastenders.

NICHOLAS CORSELLIS (QFB HOLLIS WHITEMAN)




